Historic Houses, Old filling stations, Old barns, churches, bridges, trees, old Chapin Theater, water towers, river/ponds, scenes from the lake side in Chapin, old buildings, streets and faces of the community...etc.

Using any medium: Oil, Watercolor, Acrylic, Color Pencil, Charcoal

The finished size of the actual painting should be no more than 11x14, however, for watercolor and color pencil that does not include up to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " mat.

Would prefer a small 1 1/2" black frame. (no more than 2")

If you choose to participate "do not sign your painting". You will be given a number to place on the back of the painting in the upper right hand corner.

Due date April 15th, 2017

OPTION: The paintings will be collected on April 15th and a non partial artist outside the League will judge and select three paintings for an award to be announced.

All paintings will be first shown in the May program of the League. Each participating artist will present their painting and give a very brief history of the painting and why they chose their subject matter. (No more than 1-2 mins.) During this meeting the three award paintings will be announced.

Initially, all entries will hang in the TAP Gallery from the May meeting in 2017 until the end of June when we hope to work with some of the local banks of Chapin/Prosperity to display these paintings during July and August. We will do our best to acquire a venue where we can advertise and those interested can sell their work.

There is also an option under consideration to ask the judging artist to select 12 paintings to be used in a "Scenes of Chapin, Prosperity and Little Mountain Calendar" to be placed around in local business and surrounding area for sale. This could be a good way to create some revenue for the league.

If you are interested in participating in this special program. Please fill in the attached form and return to Ann Peake this evening. Include your email address and telephone number. Afterwards, go home pick your subject and begin your painting....... I suggest that you keep your painting "under hat" until the showing in May. There are many wonderful landmarks around the communities and they are sadly and quickly disappearing. Make yours one that will stand the test of time!

Note: Once your painting is finished and before it is framed please take a good photo of the painting using the jpeg format. Should you decide to use watercolor/acrylic make sure to take a photo of the painting prior to putting it under glass. Send these photos to ann-eake@bellsouth.net as soon as available. You will need to include the name of the painting and the address.
