Pouring Watercolor in Layers

Students will learn to use masking fluid and liquid watercolor to create a painting with little or no brushwork. After completing a class project, students will apply the technique to their own images.

Students will need to bring Pebeo Masking Fluid, 5 sealable containers to mix their paint in, (plastic or glass), 5 pipettes, an old bathmat or a couple of old bath towels, a small bar of soap or a small container of brush soap, an inexpensive brush for the application of masking fluid such as Cheap Joe's Ugly Brushes, a wide flat brush, paper towels, and their normal selection of paints, brushes, and palette.
