- Paints– Bring your favorite Red, Yellow, Blue, Quinacridone Gold, and Prussian Blue\
- Paper – Arches 140# or 300# Cold Press -either will work
- Brushes – 1 or 2 “ Flat, a scrubber. 4-5 pipettes
- Masking – Pebeo drawing gum is my favorite. Old brush or Ugly brush to apply & rubber cement remover. If you do not have or use masking, I will have small kits available at the workshop for \$20.00 that includes a small bottle of masking, a couple brushes, a remover, and pipettes.
- Palette – white tray or palette
- Water container, paper towels & facial tissues (very important), artists tape, eraser, spray bottle (this is important that it have a significant spray down to a mist-I recommend Cheap Joe’s), small lidded plastic containers to mix paint (about 4 oz. available on Amazon). A heavy, old bath towel or bath mat
- Resource material: I will send you a line drawing to transfer to your paper BEFORE the workshop
- You can use transfer paper to trace your line drawing onto your watercolor paper. No smaller than 9x12 or larger than 15x30. Please leave a border to tape off edges.
