BASIC PLEIN AIR SUPPLY LIST

This is a generic supply list. Please feel free to add or delete items based on your needs and preferences.

- Dress accordingly:
 - Check the local weather forecast, with provisions for rain or changing weather.
 - Bring a hat to shade from the sun's glare.
- Portable easel
- Canvas/panel/paper to paint on:
 - Recommended size: 8×10" to 12×16".
 - Please prepare your support based on the type of paint you will be using prior to the workshop.
- Paints:
 - Demonstrations will be given in watercolor. You are welcome to work in your favorite medium of choice.
 - If you are new to plein air, remember that you may want to limit the number of tubes or bottles that you carry.
- Palette: wood with a nice patina or Plexiglas.
- Painting medium: optional.
- Solvent to clean brushes (oil: odorless mineral spirits; watercolor/acrylic: water; acrylic: water).
- Brushes

- Palette knife for mixing paint
- Paper Towels
- Small trash bag for soiled towels
- Insect repellent and sunscreen
- Folding chair if needed
- Snack, bottled water

Be sure to have a shallow cardboard box in your car to keep your painting safely secure when traveling home.
