

He was also honored for his many contributions to art and the State of South Carolina by the South Carolina House of Representatives and was awarded an Honorary Doctorate of Fine Arts by the University of South Carolina.

Specifications

Entries are limited to original two-dimensional works that reflect the theme. Categories are paintings, drawings, mixed media and photography. No copied work or reproductions will be accepted. All work must be securely wired and framed or mounted. We cannot accommodate work larger than 48 inches in either direction.

Entry Fee

Artists may register online on the Jim Harrison Gallery website through March 1, 2020. The registration fee is \$20 for one piece \$30 for up to 3 pieces. Artists are limited to 3 pieces each.

Sale of Work

Unless indicated on the entry card, all work will be for sale through Jim Harrison Gallery. An artist may have only one item listed not for sale. The gallery will charge a 40% commission on all sales.

Liability

Insurance is the responsibility of the owner of the artwork. The gallery staff and Dogwood committee will handle the artwork with care but neither the gallery nor the festival committee will be responsible for loss or damage. The Dogwood Festival committee reserves the right to photograph and reproduce any entry for promotional purposes.

Awards

Jurors will select Best of show, first, second and third place awards for each category. The number of entries will determine the amount of the awards. Artists whose work is selected will be notified by March 10, 2020.
